### Geriatric Practice

Its focus on symptom management and maximization of function is essential in maintaining quality of life. Pain, a frequent symptom in all cancer patients, presents in the older cancer patient specific barriers for evaluation and treatment. Non-pain symptoms are multiple, frequent and debilitating.
