The practice and rules state that both sides are supposed to disclose all of the evidence that they have to the other side prior to the trial date but that does not exclude either side from bringing up evidence during the

trial that either side has not seen or known of prior to the trial -- typically the party will have to ask the court for permission to bring in the new evidence (because it was not disclosed) and then the judge will decide if bringing in the evidence or letting the evidence ...

**(1) Can "new" evidence be introduced DURING a criminal trial?**

This will serve as evidence for your trial. You may have to provide a copy of the document(s) to the party you are suing, as well as to the Judge. So it is important to bring two copies along with the original of any documents that you intend to bring in as evidence. Note: It may be useful for you to write down everything you want to tell the Judge before your trial so you do not forget anything.
