The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when "paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work" (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

In-Text Citations: Citations are placed in the context of discussion using the author's last name and date of publication. When a work has no identified author, cite in text the first few words of the article title using double quotation marks, "headline-style" capitalization, and the year. However, APA tends to reserve this type of citation for a very small set of sources: for example, The Bible and some dictionaries and encyclopedias such as Wikipedia (which should not form a central part of your research). If an item has no author, start the citation with the article title. When an article has one to seven authors, all authors' names are cited in the References List entry. When an article has eight or more authors list the first six authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (...), and then the last author's name.

A web page is a computer file on the web, which includes text, images and/or other forms of data. If referring to an individual web page with a name (e.g. About us) or a document on a web page with a title (or multiple pages from a website), you must reference each page both in the text and in the References list.

According to The APA Style Guide to Electronic References, 6th edition, you should use the DOI format which the article appears with. So, if it is using the older numeric string, use that as the DOI. If, however, it is presented as the newer alpha-numeric string, use that as the DOI.
